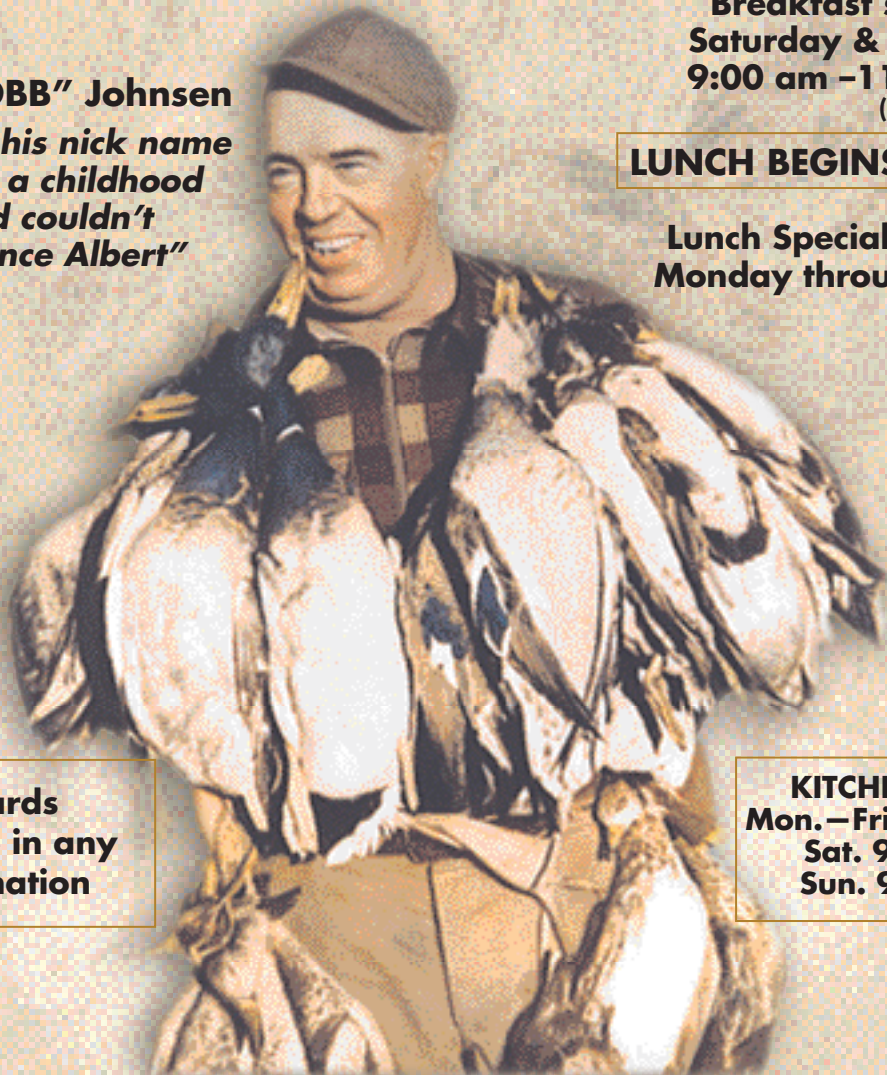

OBB'S HISTORY . . .

In the early days, where the street cars turned-around at the intersection of Burns, Point Douglas Road and Clarence Street, stood OBB's Sports Bar & Grill.

Originating in 1919 as a grocery and feed store, the building underwent remodeling around 1934 and became one of the many bars in St. Paul to be licensed after the repeal of Prohibition.

Here it remains after 51 years, until it changed hands in 1982. Now it's back in the hands of the original family – The Johnsen's. Even though Bob Johnsen and his brother Glenn retired in 1982. Jim, son of Bob and Rosie, currently owns OBB's.

The Johnsen's are now working hard to maintain the quality and service their customers have come to expect. We hope that the OBB's atmosphere is still that of an old time bar, complete with excellent service and tradition that will remain for years to come.

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STEAK & EGGS

8oz. Sirloin cooked to order with two eggs, hashbrowns and toast. 16.45

EGGS BENEDICT

Two poached eggs atop grilled ham and toasted english muffin, covered with hollandaise and served with hashbrowns. 13.95

THE OLD STAND-BY

Two eggs, choice of meat and toast. 11.45

CAJUN MEATLOAF BENEDICT

Seasoned cajun meatloaf, sauteed onions, special sauce served with 2 eggs on an English muffin then covered with hollandaise sauce. 13.95

OBB'S OMELET

Your choice of meat (ham, bacon or sausage) with blended veggies (tomatoes, onions, mushrooms and peppers) served with mixed cheese and hashbrowns. 13.45

MEXICAN OMELET

Stuffed with taco meat, jalapenos, onions, black olives and tomatoes with mix cheese served with hashbrowns. 14.95

OBB'S TOSTADA

Fried tortilla layered with scrambled eggs, taco meat, black beans and smothered with pork green chili sauce and chipotle ranch 14.45

FRENCH TOAST 10.95 With meat 13.45

TRADITIONAL

Two eggs, choice of meat, hashbrowns and toast. 13.45

EGGS & CAKES

Two eggs with two homemade buttermilk pancakes and choice of meat. 13.45

OBB'S BISCUITS & GRAVY

Two biscuits smothered with Obb's country gravy served with two eggs. 12.95

FRIED EGG SANDWICH WITH CHEESE

9.25 With choice of meat 11.95

COUNTRY FRIED STEAK

Homemade gravy, hashbrowns, 2 eggs and toast 14.45

CHORIZO BURRITO

Start with 12" flour tortilla stuffed with scrambled eggs, chorizo sauce and served on a bed of hashbrowns and smothered with melted cheddar jack cheese, pork green chili sauce and garnished with chipotle ranch and fresh cilantro. 16.45
